**July 7-13** (Sun – Sat) **Camp Courageous Caravan.** We will be working as volunteer counselors alongside paid staff at a camp for children and teens with special needs. You will work long hours, do meaningful work that will help campers have a great week, and have a great time doing it. We will stay at the camp and share meals with campers in the dining hall. You do not need experience with special needs individuals, nor do you need to have a desire to make it a related field a career. Compassion and energy are the two most important things to bring. We will take up to 10 people. Participant contribution is \$200.

**NEW!!! July 21-27** (Sun-Sat) **Camp Courageous Work Caravan.** We are bringing back an old tradition this summer by returning to Camp Courageous but this time to work on the grounds and to help on projects to better the experience for campers! We will stay in a different part of the camp but still eat in the dining hall. It's like bringing all of the best of caravans together for one great week long experience! We will take up to 10 people. Participant contribution is \$200.

### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- There is one registration form for the two caravans. It is possible to go on more than one caravan; please be clear on your application about what you would ideally like to do.
- We ask that ALL youth participate in fundraising activities to support the total costs of Summer Caravans.
- We ask that **parents read** through their teen's registration and **sign the first page**. It is important for parents to be aware of the application process and the commitment involved.
- Do not let money be an obstacle to going on the trip of your choice! Full and partial scholarships are available. Contact Pastor Susan for details.
- APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BY Sunday, May 5 (Last Sunday of program year). Late applications will only be considered if there are spaces available, so get your applications in on time!
- **A \$150 deposit** should be turned in with your caravan application regardless of how many caravans you are applying for.
- On **Sunday July 28**, all caravans will be reporting at the 9:30 AM worship service. Thank you for making a commitment to present in worship on this day.
