After Growing with God, all children are invited to join our leaders in faith formation class where they will learn about Psalm 111 by participating in a game, doing a craft and watching a video.




CPC Youth will return on 2/18! 5-7:30 pm

SUNDAY MORNING ADULT ED February 11 10:45-11:45 am


Knowledge: The Evidential Reformation aka The Renaissance of Wonder
