Thus said King Cyrus of Persia: The Eternal God of Heaven has given me all the kingdoms of the earth and has charged me with building Him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah Anyone of you of all His people –may his God be with you, and let him go up to Jerusalem that is in Judah and build the House of the Eternal God of Israel the God that is in Jerusalem and all that stay behind wherever he may be living, let the people of his place assist him silver, gold, goods and livestock besides the freewill offering to the House of God that is in Jerusalem.

9. Rashi

He (God) commanded me (Cyrus) through Isaiah the prophet to build for Him the Temple in Jerusalem as it says in the book of Isaiah (44:28-45:1) "He is My shepherd /He shall fulfill all my purposes/He shall say of Jerusalem, 'She shall be rebuilt'/And to the Temple: 'You shall be founded again' Thus said The Eternal to Cyrus, His anointed one-/Whose right hand He has grasped" This had already been conveyed through prophecy by Isaiah.
