


CPC CONCERT SERIES PRESENTS: Avalon String Quartet Sunday, April 28, 3:00 pm

CPC welcomes the Avalon String Quartet, one of the country's leading string chamber music ensembles. They have performed in major venues including Carnegie Hall, Alice Tully Hall, and the 92nd St Y in New York; the Library of Congress and National Gallery of Art in Washington DC, and have appeared internationally. Avalon is quartet-in-residence at the

Northern Illinois University School of Music.

They will perform a classical string quartet concert featuring Florence Price's G Major Quartet No. 1, Dmitri Shostakovich's Quartet No. 9 in E-flat Major, and the Antonín Dvořák Quartet No. 13 in G Major. Price and Dvořák brim with charm, lyricism, and lush harmonies, contrasted by the intense brooding voice of Shostakovich. The musicians are Blaise Magnière (violin), Marie Wang (violin), Anthony Devroye (viola), and Cheng-Hou Lee (cello).


NOMINATING COMMITTEE
